New Zealand as a full motorcycle loop — start & finish in Auckland.

25 days (24 nights), **approx. 6,650 km**, **20 riding days** and ~95% asphalt: pure flow for riders who want the real thing.

No filler — every day earns its place. No compromises.

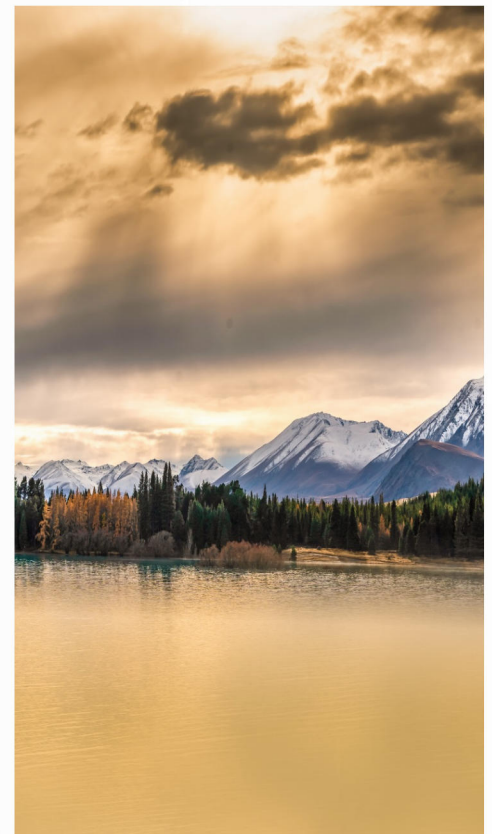
- Small groups of max. 7 riders — no chaos, no waiting. A tight crew that moves smoothly and rides smart.
- Carefully selected, authentic stays with real New Zealand character — coastal hideaways and mountain towns, chosen for location and atmosphere.
- Daily briefings — clear plan, key highlights, safety notes, and photo points.
- **Your tour guide speaks English, Spanish, and German** — easy communication, fast answers.

Top Highlights

- **Cape Reinga** & the Far North — where oceans meet and the ride feels like the edge of the world.
- **Mount Taranaki** (volcano) / Te Papa-Kura-o-Taranaki National Park — a near-perfect cone and unforgettable backdrop.
- 2 days in **Golden Bay** + optional Abel Tasman hike stage — time to reset and roll out refreshed.
- **Kaikōura** with **whale watching** + optional whale flight — dramatic coastline and the chance to see giants.
- **Lake Tekapo**: 4x4 mountain tour into the Mackenzie high country — wide-open landscapes and South Island scale.
- **Overnight cruise on Doubtful Sound** & visit to **Milford Sound** — waterfalls, steep fjords, a night unplugged.
- West Coast scenery with the **Pancake Rocks** — rugged shoreline and nature running the show.

And that was just the warm-up — the best is yet to come.

◦ **Day 0 – Arrival in Auckland**

Check-in, meet & settle in. Welcome dinner at Orbit 360°.

◦ **Day 1 – Auckland → Bay of Islands (Paihia)**

Tour kickoff, briefing, first riding day up north.

◦ **Day 2 → Cape Reinga → Ahipara**

Cape Reinga & the far north: scenic, wild coastal roads + Ninety Mile Beach.

Ahipara Bay with its impressive unspoiled beauty and spectacular sunsets.

◦ **Day 3 → Coromandel Peninsula (Thames)**

Ride south via twisty backroads.

Tāne Mahuta, legendary kauri (2000 years+) in Waipoua Forest. Plus Te Matua Ngahere - even older (2,500–3,000 years).

Rawene Ferry crossing - quick local hop with real Kiwi flavour. Coromandel vibes.

◦ **Day 4 → Tauranga → Rotorua**

Big adventure day: 486 km of pure New Zealand riding - challenging, rewarding, unforgettable.

Coromandel Loop: ride north, then carve east around the Coromandel Peninsula to a stunning far-east lookout.

Coastal vibes: roll into Tauranga, one of NZ's best-known seaside towns.

◦ **Day 5 – Rest / Experience Day (Rotorua region)**

Flexible day for local highlights:

Hell's Gate Geothermal Reserve & Mud Spa - geothermal walk + mud experience.

Māori culture highlight: myths, legends, and living history in the geothermal heartland.

Evening experience at the Māori village Tū Te Rā.

Te Puia area: traditional storytelling by Māori hosts.

Traditional Māori dinner - authentic, shared group night to round off the rest day.

◦ **Day 6 → Lake Taupō → Taihape**

Huka Falls stop: roaring turquoise water and one of NZ's most iconic viewpoints.

Wai-O-Tapu Thermal Wonderland: colourful geothermal landscapes and steaming pools.

Lady Knox Geyser (10:15): reliable eruption show - up to 10–20 m high.

Lake Taupō shoreline: sweeping views as we head east.

Desert Road ride: dramatic scenery past Mount Ruapehu - constantly changing landscapes.

Overnight in Taihape: classic small-town NZ vibe.

◦ **Day 7 → Martinborough (South Wairarapa)**

Destination: Martinborough charming wine town near Lake Wairarapa.

Meet the locals: a unique visit via our local connection - authentic New Zealand beyond the tourist track.

Colonial-style town vibe - classic Kiwi small-town atmosphere at its best.

Wine country highlight: 20+ wineries packed into one legendary region.

Premium stay: iconic Martinborough hotel.

Food & wine culture: tasting sessions and relaxed evening in the heart of NZ wine country.

◦ **Day 8 → Wellington (“Windy City” with a “Wellywood” soul)**

Route through the Akatarawa Valley - link between Upper Hutt (Hutt Valley area) and Waikanae (Kāpiti Coast).

Quick stop: Jock Atkins Waterfall, right by the roadside.

Evening: private BBQ with our local Kiwi host.

◦ **Day 9 → Cook Strait ferry → Golden Bay (Takaka)**

Early start: hotel departure 07:00, check-in 07:30, ferry departs 08:45 (tour schedule).

Cook Strait crossing: approx. 92–96 km, around 4 hours - via Wellington Harbour and into the fjord-like Marlborough Sounds.

Rider's highlight: Queen Charlotte Drive - nearly 40 km of winding Marlborough Sounds curves, native forest on one side, sea views on the other, plus plenty of viewpoint stops.

Continue west via the Nelson/Tasman region towards the Abel Tasman gateway.

Into Golden Bay via Tākaka Hill - the legendary “Marble Mountain” road, packed with scenery and lookout stops.

◦ **Day 10 – Golden Bay Rest Day**

No riding today - full reset in Takaka / Golden Bay.

Sleep in, coffee, slow morning (no schedule, no pressure).

Beach time: sun + sea + pure Golden Bay.

Optional: Abel Tasman Coast Track hike (5–6 hrs) - transfer to the trailhead; finish back near our accommodation.

◦ **Day 11 → Lewis Pass → Hanmer Springs**

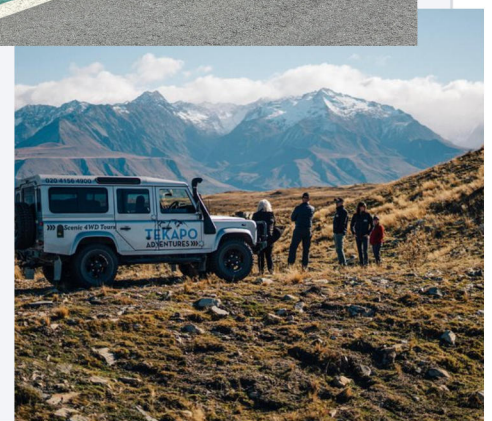
Back in the saddle: a proper South Island riding day.

Lewis Pass - 907 m: smooth sweepers through native forest.

Constant scenery change: forest - river valleys - mountains.

Plenty of clean, quick photo stops (no detours).

Reward: natural thermal pools to loosen up after the kilometres.



- **Day 12 → Lake Tekapo (Mackenzie District)**
Ride the quiet Hurunui backroads: river valleys, farmland, sweeping bends.
Across rural North Canterbury: tiny towns, NZ heartland.
Final approach into Mackenzie Country: golden tussock, huge views, Southern Alps backdrop.
- **Day 13 – Reset Day + Private Wilderness Experience**
Lake Tekapo rest day: sleep in, lakefront chill, explore freely.
Included highlight: private 4x4 off-road, 2 Land Rovers, guides.
Mackenzie backcountry: Lake Pukaki/glacier views + remote valleys + sheep stations.
- **Day 14 → Mosgiel (Dunedin – “Edinburgh of the South”)**
Architecture wow: one of the Southern Hemisphere’s best-preserved Victorian/Edwardian cityscapes.
Otago Peninsula - wildlife coast with chances to spot penguins (little blue + rare yellow-eyed) and fur seals/sea lions.
- **Day 15 → Fiordland: Manapouri + Pātea Doubtful Sound**
Fiordland day - heading into NZ’s most iconic wilderness.
Epic access route: Lake Manapouri cruise + coach over the Wilmot Pass (rainforest gravel road) to Deep Cove.
Tonight: no hotel - overnight on the boat in Doubtful Sound.
Wildlife chances: dolphins, penguins - whales possible.
- **Day 16 → Back on the bikes: Milford Sound**
Milford Road - there & back: the only way in/out - big views.
Milford Sound: time to explore (rain = waterfall mode).
Overnight Te Anau on the lake - perfect Fiordland base.
- **Day 17 → Glenorchy → Arrowtown → Lake Wānaka**
Easy morning, then ride: today is pure “lakes + mountains + flow” (no rush, but a proper ride day).
LOTR highlight: beech forest toward Paradise/Glenorchy - Fangorn Forest filming territory.
Must-do detour: Queenstown - Glenorchy Road hugging Lake Wakatipu - nonstop viewpoints along the water.
Finish in Wānaka: roll in early evening + straight to the lakefront (easy walk, instant wow).
- **Day 18 → Hokitika (approx. 420 km riding day)**
West Coast mission: Wānaka - Haast Pass - Glacier Country - Hokitika - all ride, no filler.
Haast Pass Highway: 140 km across the alpine divide.
Glacier Country (Fox/Franz Josef): glaciers meet coastal rainforest - crazy-rare scenery combo.
Hokitika finish: Tasman Sea + Southern Alps backdrop - camera storage at risk.
- **Day 19 → Pancake Rocks → Kaikōura (Whale Coast)**
Punakaiki Pancake Rocks: coastal limestone “stacked pancakes” + blowholes - quick stop, huge wow.

Lewis Pass - Kaikōura: alpine crossing to NZ’s whale coast - overnight in Kaikōura + optional early-morning whale flight (plane/helicopter, weather/availability).

- **Day 20 → North Island switch → Wellington**
Picton (ferry 14:15) through the Marlborough Sounds to Welly.
Kāpiti Coast finish (Waikanae): beachside check-in + Kiwi BBQ tonight - perfect setup for tomorrow’s rest day.
- **Day 21 – Rest Day: Kāpiti Coast + Wellington (optional)**
Optional city day: hop on the Kāpiti Line train straight into Wellington - easy, scenic, and stress-free.
Te Papa (NZ’s national museum): the best crash course in New Zealand - incl. strong Māori culture focus.
Film nerd bonus (optional): Wētā Workshop (Miramar) - movie-magic, props & behind-the-scenes craft.
- **Day 22 → Taranaki Maunga → New Plymouth**
Whanganui pass-through: home of the Cemetery Circuit street race (running since 1951).
Taranaki Maunga: near-perfect cone stratovolcano, formed over ~130,000 years, last erupted 1854.
Into Te Papa-Kura-o-Taranaki (formerly Egmont National Park) - the volcano dominates the park.
- **Day 23 → West Coast Icons → Forgotten World Highway**
Tongapōrutu “Three Sisters” stop: 25 m sea stacks (now two remain) - walkable at low tide for the full wow.
Forgotten World Highway: 148 km of remote, historic backroad atmosphere through tiny settlements and “old NZ” scenery.
Bonus kicker: the Moki Tunnel - 180 m, single-lane (proper adventure vibe).
Overnight Ōtorohanga + Waitomo must-do: relaxed boat ride in the Glowworm Grotto under thousands of glowworms.
- **Day 24 → Finale ride + Raglan detour → Auckland**
Auckland ~16:00 + farewell dinner: bikes parked, stories shared - optional Karioi Canyoning for one last adrenaline hit.
